GENERAL RULES-ETHIC CHARTER

1 - General rules

1-1 • Drawn up from the general and official regulation about trade exhibitions, this regulation is adapted to ZOOM by fatex specialties. All those clauses apply with full rights to everybody, exhibitors and visitors. Rights and obligations which result from it are strictly personal and can't be transferred under whatever form, even gracefully, without express and previous agreement of EUROVET.

1-2 • By signing their booking form, exhibitors promise to respect, without any restriction or reserve, the clauses of this regulation and all new clauses who could be imposed by circumstances and adopted in favour of the show by the Organiser, who reserves the right to indicate them, even verbally. In other respects, the regulation is stucked at the Exhibition Secretariat, where it can be consulted for all duration of the show.

2 - Conditions for admission

2-1 • Only professional makers, subcontractors, co-contractors, technology and haberdashery suppliers and all subcontracting services, additional activities suppliers and designers, pattern-makers and trend companies are authorized to exhibit, according to the rules established by the Board of Directors.

2-2 • Exhibitor selection criteria and procedures Zoom by Fatex is a selective trade show. Access is reserved to manufacturers, subcontractors and garment-makers from the Euromed Zone, enlarged to include Madagascar and Mauritius, working on outsourcing in the mid to top-end apparel, household textiles and fashion accessories sectors, whose applications are accepted by the Selection Committee, which works to ensure that the show's overall product range is constantly enriched. Fulfilling one or several of the criteria outlined below does not guarantee the acceptance of an application. Company applications are required to mention and fully comply with each point stipulated. The following criteria are taken into account during the selection process:

QUALITY AND ADDED VALUE : Applicant companies shall contribute to reinforcing the pertinence of the show offering, by providing specific know-how and added-value to the products manufactured.

PRODUCTION FACILITIES : Zoom by Fatex favours companies that offer direct and full control of their production facilities. Service quality : Companies selected are required to offer services relevant to a complex, targeted and international demand: short turnaround times, low minimum orders, special developments. While these criteria may be given positive consideration in the selection process, they do not suffice for the acceptance of an application.

CAPACITY TO RESPOND TO INTERNATIONAL DEMAND : Irrespective of their country of origin, companies must be capable of providing a satisfactory response to the worldwide demand for sampling and production expressed at the show.

COMMERCIAL REPUTATION : Applicant companies shall not be involved in known litigation with the reputable exhibitors and/or buyers at Zoom by Fatex, in particular in the domain of counterfeiting. Applications should, on the contrary, be supported by a portfolio of customers and suppliers which also enjoy an impeccable reputation on an international scale.

EXPERIENCE AND FINANCIAL STABILITY : Applicant companies shall demonstrate legal and operational experience of at least two years. Companies' capacities to fulfil short-term requirements will be evaluated, as well as their ability to maintain and develop their business and turnover in the mid-term. Accounting and legal documents must be supplied to the Committee.

COMPLIANCE WITH ETHICAL CRITERIA : Companies that fail to comply with the social and environmental criteria commonly accepted by major international authorities (ILO, EU, etc.) shall not be selected. Selection process and participation conditions. All exhibitors at Zoom by Fatex are subject to a compulsory selection process carried out by the Selection Committee. The takeover of an exhibitor company does not guarantee the selection of any of the buyer's additional business activities which have not yet been selected. Only those applications which EUROVET has judged as suitable shall be presented to the Selection Committee: duly completed applications, complying with the current selection criteria, accompanied by the appropriate supporting documents (brochures, balance sheet, etc.). Should changes in an exhibitor's business, financial situation and/or commercial practices mean that they no longer comply with the show's selection criteria, they may not be invited to participate in subsequent editions. Any change in activity, product range, financial structure or commercial practice may call into question the company's show participation. Admission and participation at the show only apply to the conditions in which the company was admitted. Applications rejected by the Selection Committee may be renewed for the subsequent session, provided that new elements are supplied.

2-3 • The Organiser gives a decision on the admissions without being obliged to justify his decision. One admission rejection does not engender any indemnity. In this case, sums paid are simply repaid.

3 - Booking form - Payment

3-1 • The booking form is valid only if it is filled in due form, signed and accompanied by a deposit cheque of 50% account on the total amount incluing V.A.T. constituted by the booking fee(s), the surface and the corner(s). Sent after the deadline, it would be accepted only from a conditional point of view. The balance of the booking form would have to be paid by check or bank transfer upon receipt of the invoice, on 08/01/2010 at the latest.

3-2 • Additional services orders could be registered only if they are accompanied by a total payment. If they are received less than one month before the show, they will be increased by 15%.

3-3 • In case of payment delay or no payment, due sums totality will be increased by 1,5 times legal interest rate by delay month. The no payment in the due dates engenders the loss of all rights for the stand occupation and any sums paid or due to EUROVET shall retained by the organiser, who can, in addition, ask for the due balance.

3-4 • The organiser reserves the right to take security on exhibited items and stand decoration in case of outstanding payments or of reclamations engendering charges or indemnities.

3-5 • In the event of cancellation, whatever the period, received sums shall retained by the Organiser, whatever their amount.

3-6 • If the exhibitor should fail to take possession of his stand at 5pm the day before the opening of the Exhibition, he will be considered as resigned. The organiser may therefore dispose of the stand without any refund or compensation.

3-7 • Without the organiser's prior consent, an exhibitor shall not transfer, sub-let or share, all or part of his concession within the Exhibition.

4 - Withdrawal

The signing of the booking form, constitutes a firm commitment. All withdrawals shall be communicated by the Exhibitor, by registered letter, with return receipt, sent to the Organizer.

5 - Allocation of stands

5-1 • The Organiser establishes the lay out of the exhibition and allocates sites, taking into account, as far as possible, the wishes expressed by the exhibitors, the nature of their products, the date on which the application was arrived, pre-established lay outs..., and this, in the limit of available surfaces. The exhibitor can't, in any case, ask for a particular location whatever his seniority or his participation importance.

6 - Organiser's obligations

6-1 • The Organiser makes a point of the good progress of the manifestation, the dates, times and places indicated in the participation file, except in a case of absolute necessity, of supplying accessory services, accepted and paid. General Administration services are at exhibitors disposal during opening hours for any information, in order to resolve problems and to stop infringements.

6-2 • The Organiser implements security and control services regarding essentially entrance to the show and protection against thefts.

6-3 • The Organiser provides the exhibition catalogue. The necessary information for the writing of the catalogue is furnished with the booking form by the exhibitor who is responsible for all information he supplies for entry into the catalogue. The organiser can refuse the entry of some texts if they may cause harm to other exhibitors or the exhibition itself. He must take great pains to make the catalogue, without being possible to recognize his responsibility in case of omission or mistake, because of the short time of the periods between the information supplying and making-up. The organiser reserves right to publish and sell the catalogue.

7 - Exhibitor's obligations

7-1 • The exhibitor must present on his stand only his products or services manufactured or designed by himself and enumerated in the booking form if they are accepted by the Organiser as corresponding to the exhibition nomenclature. He can't advertise any of the companies if they didn't pay their own booking fee.

7-2 • The exhibitor accepts in anticipation any control which could be applied by EUROVET, in order to check the respect of admission criteria.

7-3 • Each exhibitor has to know, respect and make respect security, hygiene, stands organisation, traffic rules, imposed by Public Power or specific to the exhibition as they result from above mentioned rules or from complementary measures that Organiser could take in order to make himself secure, immediately compulsory and applying measures. «Safety» articles and conditions of the exhibition site will be put at his disposal by the Organiser.

7-4 • As a mark of respect for visitors and other exhibitors, each exhibitor has to respect opening and closing hours foretold by the Organiser and promises in anticipation to have a permanent presence on his stand for all the official opening duration of the show. Any abuse duly established by the organizer may be subject to a financial penalty set by the Board of Directors.

7-5 • The use of stands structures supplied by the Organiser is obligatory. Installations made by the exhibitor on his stand could neither, in any case, exceed the volume of the modular stand and 1,50 m high, nor harm next stands or general decoration and exhibition spirit. It is totally prohibited to modify stands structures and to add any decorative element which could damage the structures supplied by the Organiser.

7-6 • Any particular additional fitting will have to be asked for to the Organiser and security services.

7-7 • Any damage caused by the exhibitor to the locations, decors, equipment put at his disposal and also to the equipment and buildings accomodating the show will be at his charge.

7-8 • Each exhibitor provides for transport and reception of parcels sent to him. In case of the Exhibitor's absence, the Organiser is not held responsible for thefts, losses or damages caused to the parcels. It will be the same for objects or parcels left without any surveillance by the exhibitor, or on the exhibition place before and after the build-up and dismantling periods, indicated on the technical guide.

8 - Insurance

8-1 • The Organiser is insured for his public liability. The exhibitor has to take out, at his own charges, any insurance he will consider necessary, covering all risks that himself or his staff run or make other people run, any thefts or damages. The Organiser disclaims his responsibility in this case. The Organiser can't be held responsible for thefts or damages of exhibitors or visitors clothes or objects, even they are given to the cloakroom, or for prejudices or incidents resting with the person who rents the place.

8-2 • The exhibitor renounces at any resort, malevolence excepted, against the Lessor of the exhibition site of the Show and against the Organiser, for any material damages and/or immaterial damages (exploitation loss or entitlement loss) consecutive or non-consecutive, caused to the exhibitor, resulting from fire, explosion, collapse or water damage of which the responsibility would rest with the Lessor and the Organiser and their respective insurers. He promises to obtain a waiver to identical recourse for his insurers for whom he goes bail facing the Lessor and the Organiser and facing their respective insurers. He also promises to obtain a waiver to identical recourse for his potential suppliers and their insurers facing the Lessor and the Organiser, those suppliers having to go bail facing the Lessor and the Organiser of the waiver to recourse of their insurers.

8-3 • Exception made for malevolence actions of the exhibitor and/or of any person acting on his behalf, the Lessor and the Organiser and their respective insurers give up all thoughts of recourse against the exhibitor and his insurance companies.

• For any material or immaterial damage (exploitation loss or entitlement loss) consecutive and/or non-consecutive, caused to the Lessor, his goods (building, equipments) or his employees, and also to the Organiser and resulting from fire, explosion, collapse or water damage of which the responsibility would rest to the exhibitor or his partners acting on his behalf.

• And promise irrevocably that insurance policies they will take out include a waiver to recourse from the part of their respective insurance companies.

9 - Photographs/Trademarks

The Exhibitor expressly authorizes the Organizer, at no charge, to make photographs and/or films, if it wishes, representing him and the members of his team, as well as the products on exhibit on his stand; to utilize these images freely on allmedia, in particular for advertising purposes, in France and abroad, without any limitation in time to quote and reproduce its trademark, or company name, at no charge, as a commercial reference for the purposes of its advertising, on all media in France and abroad, and for a period of five years following the date of the signing of this contract.

10 - Practical dispositions

Badges • The Organiser gives a personal badge to each exhibitor, to his co-workers and to each visitor for the show. This badge allows the access to the exhibition space. It has to be worn for all duration of the show.

Hours • Opening hours for visitors, build-up and dismantling hours are communicated in the Technical Guide. During the show, access to exhibition halls is allowed to exhibitors one hour before the opening hours for visitors and one hour after the closing.

Distribution • Any flyers, brochures or advert items distribution and any other kind of solicitation out of your stand are strictly prohibited and also newspapers or periodical publications and any kind of survey, except consent of the Organiser. Generally speaking, any commercial action made by some sales representatives of non exhibiting companies in the show is strictly prohibited. The Organiser could pronounce the immediate exclusion of the contraveners.

Selling • Direct selling is strictly prohibited.

Pa system • Any Public Adress System will have to be consented by the Organiser.

Electricity • All installations must be complied with the directives decreed by the Police Headquarters. If those standards are not respected, the Safety Commission could impose the simple closing of the stand.

Suppliers • Only body corporates or natural persons authorized by the Organiser can intervene on the show. Those will be given a badge which will assert it.

Smoking is forbidden • Related to the decree n°2006-1386 of November 15th , 2006, fixing the application conditions for forbidding smoking in public places [November 16th , 2006]. The banning concerns all closed and covered places which welcome public or which constitute a working place.

11 - Application and extension of the rules

The Organiser reserves the right to give a ruling on all cases not provided for within the present regulations. All decisions will be enforce able and final. Any violation of the provisions of the present regulations, safety rules or subsequent rules published by the Organiser may result in the exclusion of the offending exhibitor and in the closing of his stand without any repaid or indemnity. In the event of a dispute, conciliation solution will be automatically researched. If conciliation is impossible, the appropriate Court will be the Court, presided by three Judges of Hauts de Seine. One copy of this regulation could be given, at any time, to any person who would ask for it to EUROVET secretariat ship .
